HISTORY

1. Research on Drosophila study was carried on immune system because it has 70% of homology with that of human body. The salivary glands of fruit fly were used to study genetic makeup of human. This fly was chosen because of its life span, genetic makeup and physiology. Of late they are used in clinical trials.
2. The process of Skin healing during injury was explained in detail.
3. Effect of pesticides and fertilizers on sensory organs of human being, the scientist was developing cream and gels to reduce the effects of the chemicals. The scientist explained about the adoption of designing coat made up of nanoparticle which protected the body of farmer from harmful effects of chemical when they would come in contact with the pesticide. These nanoparticles have the capacity to break the sulphide bonds that is present in the pesticide.
4. Cell signalling memory synapses, structure of neurons nerves in the body was studied using model with circuits connected with different sounds produced.

COUNSELLING

Counselling is a process that enables to sort out issues and reach decisions affecting their life. Often counselling is sought out a time of change or crisis, it need not be so however as counselling can also help us at any time of our life.

Counselling involves talking with a person in a way that helps a person solve a problem or helps to create conditions that will cause person to solve a problem or helps to create conditions that will cause a person to understand and /or improve his /her behaviour, character, values or life circumstances. In the end of the counselling process, the client himself /herself as a insight to the problem and he/she becomes empowered to take his or her decision.

Conflicts, academic problems, career, personal and socially related problems than in the past. counselling programmes involves individual sessions with students, where truth serves as a mean to reach the goals of counselling. Follow up sessions are carried out as on a regular basis and parents are involved in the process if the need demands. The counsellor was also actively involved in meeting the students and parents who have shortage of attendance. They were counselled and advised to be regular to college and to maintain 75% attendance in all subjects. In future, the counsellor hopes to instil skills that will enable our students to be efficient and successful.

Counselling is defined as the service of helping people to adjust or deal with personal problems, by enabling them to discover for themselves the solution to the Problems when receiving attention from a counsellor.

The Counsellor's View point

As a counsellor, I had to deal with not counselling but also address issues and also to manage the help desk to help our students and parents. Throughout the year, I met students staff and parents addressing many issues like peer pressure, parental pressure, academic pressure and personal problems, relationship problems, depression, career guidance, shortage of attendance, misconduct, enquiries, ventilation, interpersonal problems, relationship problems and other issues. I have maintained confidentiality and dealt with each individual on a non-judgemental basis. Certain sensitive matters had to be taken up with the Principal and handled delicately. I have maintained confidential reports after every sessions and also maintained a record of work on a daily basis. I have also got feedback from students, parents and staff on the sessions that were conducted. Certain case follow up sessions were taken up by me. Students who had approached me seeking help have also brought their classmates and friends for various issues. This shows a definite positive impact of my counselling services.

PLACEMENT CELL

The main objective of the Placement Cell is to place students who are interested in working after graduation, in suitable jobs in various companies.

An awareness was created on the various industries & opportunities available in the market. Students were also assisted in internships. Students were taught resume writing and creating profiles on the various job portals like LinkedIn, Naukri, Indeed, Internshala, Youth4Work and FreshersWorld and others.

Around 25 companies were reached out to and were invited to interact with our graduating students for campus recruitment drives.

The students had the opportunity to meet recruiting teams from top of the line companies like KPMG, EY, Dell, Amazon, CapGemini, Bayer, Northern Trust Bank, Standard Chartered Bank, L&T, Wipro and other local companies like Karle, TTK, facility management companies like Savills and Novel, and startups like Tedroox and Snapwiz.

Dell has issued offer letters to 5 of our students at INR 4.2 lacs per annum, this being the highest salary that has been offered to any of our students.

Bayer has issued an offer letter to our M.Com student at INR 3.5 lacs per annum.

Northern Trust Bank has issued an offer letter to one of our students at INR 3.1 lacs per annum.

Amazon has issued an offer letter to one of our students at INR 2.5 lacs per annum.

CapGemini has to conduct the final interview for 15 of our students who have cleared the initial rounds with iPrimed.

EY has to conduct the final interview for 2 of our students who have cleared the initial rounds.

A few drives have been put on hold due to Covid19 outbreak and they will be resumed after the lockdown period is over or after the situation settles down.

PARENT TEACHER MEETING
